

Your FRRO check-list

Who has to register?

All foreigners who will be staying in India for more than five months, for whatever purpose, will have to get themselves registered at the Foreigners Regional Registration Office (FRRO)/ Foreigners Registration Office (FRO), within 14 days of arrival. Afghan nationals with a visa valid for 30 days or less are not required to register provided they give their local address to the FRRO/FRO. Foreigners who are given “exemption from police reporting” do not need to register, provided they leave before their visa expires. Foreigners from Pakistan are required to register within 24 hours of arrival.
